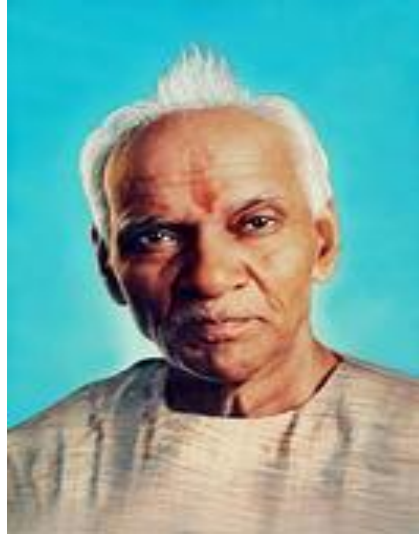


AUTHOR'S OF HINDU RELIGIOUS BOOKS (CONT.)
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During last two classes we learned about the authors of Hindu religious books such as Valmiki, Tulsidas, and Bhgavan Ved Vyas etc.



During Vasant Panchami celebration we learned that Hindu religious books, which were originally written in Sanskrit, were translated and compiled in simple language by **Pandit Shriram Sharma Acharya**. Some of these books are:

- 4 Vedas
- 108 Upanishads –Additional Upanishad “Pragyopnishad”
- 18 Puranas–Additional Puran “PragyaPuran”
- 6 Darshans
- 20 Smrutiya, YogVasistha
- GitaVishwaKosh (18 Volumes comprises of 10,000 pages)
- 108 Volumes of Vangmaya (Approx 30,000 Pages)

He wrote about **3000** enlighten-ing books in Hindi on almost all topics concerning human life. His writings carry the force of his enlightened inner self and have the power to let his thoughts reach deep into the minds and hearts of the readers. Each of his books is a milestone, a guiding pillar in the corresponding discipline of knowledge. His literature also serves as an effective means of collective enlightenment.
